

Service Outreach Opportunities

HONG KONG: Local ministries welcome visiting teams to partner with them in various types of Hong Kong focused outreach.

CHINA: Various service venues that are government authorized that serve the best interests of the host community, involving appropriately prepared teams.

NEARBY ASIAN NATIONS: Neighbouring Asian nations are also open to hosting service teams.

Service Outreach Training

Every effort will be made to assist each team in learning to honor and serve their hosts and host communities with:

- The right heart attitude including servanthood and reconciliation.
- Appropriate knowledge of the host's culture and essential introductory language vocabulary.
- Understanding of short-term visitors' role.
- Skills preparation and definition of outreach objectives.
- The capacity to consistently live and demonstrate the values and message that would most benefit their hosts.

Empowering The Gateway Services Team will assist each team by empowering them through team leadership training and the tools needed to pursue an effective service expression. Outreach venues can be secured either through our Gateway Services Network or via your own contacts. However, each team and their commissioning body will need to take final responsibility for the safety, financing, and facilitation of their own service activity.

Languages

English/Cantonese/Mandarin. Teams not speaking these languages are asked to provide their own translators.

5 Primary Phases of the HK Gateway Camp & Outreach

- 1** OUTREACH TEAM PREPARATION and HOME PERSONAL PREPARATION materials will be made available to participating teams in advance so that each team can be effectively formed and the participants can begin to prepare themselves mentally, spiritually and physically.
- 2** CAMP as described in brochure.
- 3** SERVICE OUTREACH as described in brochure.
- 4** DEBRIEF materials will be provided during the Gateway Camp. Each team should plan to conduct their own debrief time utilizing these materials over a one or two day period, ideally before returning home.
- 5** FOLLOW THROUGH TAKE HOME MATERIAL for prayer, personal devotional life and further potential steps on the Road Through China.

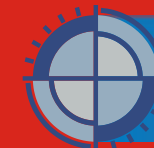
